Jesus moves **toward** us, despite our **lifestyle** or **living** situation

This is a self-mutilating soul, **shrieking** and slashing, **searching** for **satisfaction**

Satan’s plan is to **distort**, distract and **destroy** us

This **creature** recognized the **Creator**

Philippians 2:9-11

9 therefore god has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, 10 so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, 11 and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is lord, to the glory of god the father.

Jesus has power and authority over the **Deep** and **Demons**

Isaiah 61:1-2

The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because the Lord has anointed me to bring good news to the poor; he has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound; 2 to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor,

The Gospel is not a secret to be **hoarded** but a story to be **heralded**

- Who in your life does not know the story of God in your life? Are you willing to share your story this week?
- What is the ONE thing God is asking you to do this week?

PURPOSE OF SMALL GROUPS

Small groups exist to promote spiritual maturity and personal growth through deep Christian relationships through the application of God’s Word.
