- We are to be single-minded focused, and have a whole-hearted devotion
- Seek those who are hospitable, and not hostile to the gospel
- When they ask; they are open
- There is a difference between Repentance and being Really Really sorry
- Where God guides, He provides
- Our relationships we ought to point people to Jesus

PURPOSE OF SMALL GROUPS
